Aim of the Series

The main purpose of launching this series is to hopefully popularize Driving sport in North-Scandinavian and Baltic countries while giving our drivers more possibilities as well as motivation to compete at CAI2* level, giving drivers more experiences for growing up to CAI3* and higher levels.

Competition format:

Nordic Driving Challenge is an individual competition on CAI2* level in two categories - for single horses (H1) and single ponies (P1).

Every driver is allowed to drive several horses in every competition – however, one must declare one hour before the first horse inspection which horse he/she will be choosing for collecting the series ranking points. This horse should always start first in dressage competitions amongst all drivers horses.

Scoring system:

Points will be collected as per table below. Points in final will be having coef. 1.5. Results from two best legs and final will be used for total ranking. In case of equality of total points the better result in final gives preference.
